

## RESERVED EASEMENTS

- EIN 12 Access trail from the existing Port Heiden Road system near Hendrickson Lake northerly to public lands (25 foot trail).
- EIN 13 Access trail from the Port Heiden Road system southeasterly to Barabara Creek where the trail forks; the north fork parallels the right bank of Barabara Creek to public lands. The south fork roughly parallels the coast line and the right bank of the Neshik River to public lands (25 foot trail).
- EIN 31 Existing road from Port Heiden Airport southeast to Port Heiden (sixty (60) foot right-of-way).
- EIN 32 Existing road from Port Heiden southwest to road forks; one fork south to Radio Towers; the other fork extends northeasterly to another fork then southeasterly to public land (sixty (60) foot fight-of-way).
- EIN 33 Existing road from Port Heiden northwest to public lands north of Reindeer Creek (sixty (60) foot right-of-way).
