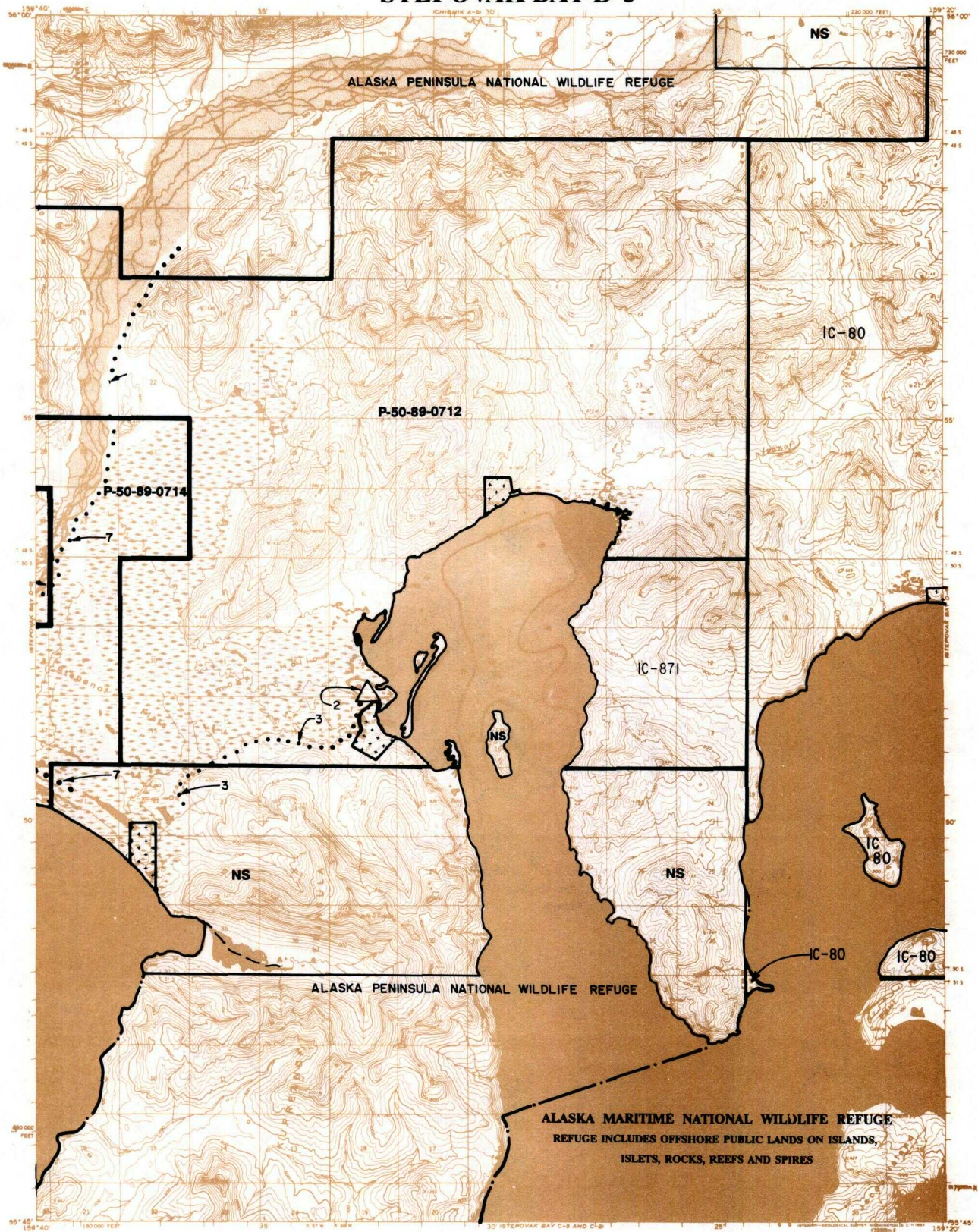

RESERVED EASEMENTS

- EIN 2 One (1) acre site easement on the Kupreanof Peninsula at the Granville Portage, in Ivanof Bay on the left bank of an unnamed slough.
- EIN 3 Proposed access trail (Granville Portage) across the Kupreanof Peninsula between Stepovak Bay and Ivanoff Bay (25 foot trail).
- EIN 7 Proposed access trail from Stepovak Bay northerly along the left bank of an unnamed stream to public lands (25 foot trail).
