RESERVED EASEMENTS

- An trail easement twenty-five (25) feet in width for a trail for use by the public to gain access to and from public land to the north and south. The easement generally parallels the coastline.
- A road easement sixty (60) feet in width for a road for use by the public to gain access to and from the Point Lay Dew Station, Point Lay, and the Pt. Lay water supply.
- A site easement, for camping and vehicle use, is located in Section 25, T. 5 N., R. 44 W., U.M. on the left bank (looking downstream) of the Kokalik River. The site easement extends twenty-five (25) feet into the water. The portion of the easement on the bed of the river is in addition to the one (1) acre on the land.
- EIN 16a A trail easement twenty-five (25) feet in width beginning on the coast just south of Tungaich Point and proceeding easterly to public land.
- **EIN 16b** A trail easement twenty-five (25) feet in width beginning approximately eight (8) miles south of Tungaich Point proceeding easterly to public land.
