





If you want to look up a particular Shore Fishery Diagram or Plat (SFDI) in a particular area:

1- Type in the SFDI number in the “Enter search text” box (e.g. - 254). Scroll down the dropdown list next to the “Select record type” and select Shore Fishery Plat (SFP) (See screen 4 below). 2- This will result in a number of plats which contain any combination of those SFDI numbers you entered, therefore you will need to scroll down the dropdown list next to “Get State Surveys” until you locate the plat you are interested in (See screen 5 below). Click “Get State Surveys” and the diagram should open up.

If you do not know the Meridian, Township, and Range (MTR) for the area of interest, you can click on the Search

Using A Map icon to locate it. Once the LandsRecords.info colored map appears, click the map in the general location of the area of interest. A more detailed quad map will appear, click once in the general area you are interested in. This will bring you back to the Alaska Land Records site, however this time all the blank boxes will be filled in. The MTR will be filled in under the Enter search text. Note: all Shore Fishery Diagrams/Plats within that MTR should be listed in the dropdown list under Get State Surveys.
